Colour

1. Choose one colour. Create a mood board for that colour by finding different shades of the colour in magazines or from unwanted materials and stick in your book in a imaginative way.
2. Crumple up a piece of white paper. Draw it in detail and add shading with a 2b pencil. Concentrate on shadow and shading.
3. Crumple up a piece of fabric. Draw it including the folds, creases and patterns. Add shading to create a 3d effect using a 2b pencil.
4. Find pictures of a range of different landscapes and stick into your book in an imaginative way.
5. Choose one of the landscapes and draw it in detail. Add colour.
6. Crumple up a piece of coloured paper. Draw it in detail including the folds and creases. Add colour.
7. Draw a view out of a window at home. Work into it using unusual and imaginative colours like the Fauvist artists.
8. Research. Find out about the work of a landscape artist. Suggestions will be given(this could be 2 lots of homework). Go to the library to research in books and on the internet. The research must be well presented with pictures and written in your own words to show understanding. Include information about the artist and his or her work. You must also include your own views and opinions about the work.
9. Your teacher will give you a list of adjectives. You must create an abstract piece of work based on the words. Use colour.
10. If a competition is held this will be a homework task.
11. Sometimes pupils will be asked to bring in items from home to use in the Art room e.g. newspapers, magazines and collage materials.
