

French and Spanish KS 4 (Yrs. 10 and 11) Homework

- In Years 10 and 11 it is essential that homework is completed thoroughly and on time. Much of the homework will consist of learning vocabulary and grammar in preparation for the modular examinations.
- Students will be tested weekly on vocabulary they have been asked to learn. The actual homework set will, obviously, be linked to the topic being studied at the time and will depend on progress made at the time. Students will have their own personal copies of the vocabulary lists which will also be available for viewing on our website.
- However, for Spanish, one essential piece of written coursework, 'Keeping Fit' is due to be completed by **OCTOBER** half-term in Year 11 and much of the homework up to this date will be exercises in preparation for this and then closer to half-term, completion of the piece of coursework itself.
- Pupils studying French will complete their first piece of coursework ("A day out") by the end of September, with the second piece ("Keeping Fit") being due before Christmas (both in Year 11).
- These pieces of coursework must be submitted by the relevant dates. If they are handed in after these dates they will not be marked resulting in candidates losing a possible 12.5% of their marks.
- Following submission of the coursework pieces, students will complete sections of the course including **Work and Lifestyle** and **The Young Person in Society** and homework will consist, as specified above, of exercises in reading, writing and revision in order for them to be thoroughly prepared for the final exams.
